

## Gender Sensitive Program

These principles are applicable for all Doordarshan programs. The production process should follow these principles:

- 1. Programs should ensure **equal representation** of women and men.
- 2. Programs should promote equality and equal opportunities for men and women.
- 3. Programs should use gender neutral/sensitive language.

## **Checklist for Producing Gender Sensitive Program**

Parameters	Description of Parameters	
Role	Content should reflect the gender role diversity and equality in terms of power, role, money & respect in social, professional and family activities. Gender roles simply mean-who does what. As the roles of gender are not fixed or constant based on difference of their sexes (except some biological abilities), the role/activities of a male or female should also not be fixed.	
Behavior	Behavior of actor/actress should challenge gender perceptions/myths. Social, family and religious rituals & symbols should question gender myths/identity to portray empowered male or female Programs and shows should show diversity in responses to a particular life situation.	
Dress	Dress of actors or presenters should break gender stereotypes.  Diversity in dress of characters help in minimizing stereotyping of a society/culture/community etc.	
Visual	Visual and composition should not show gender discrimination/ objectification on screen.  Graphics, camera angle and composition should show gender equality.	
Language	Gender sensitive language should be used in script, dialogues and narration.
